Be advised: Per the applicant's request, this office has researched the Flood Insurance Rate Map of the property as described herein.

Zone AE: Areas subject to a one percent (1%) or greater chance of flooding in any given year, commonly called 100-Year flood, where base flood elevations and flood hazard factors have been determined.

Zone X: Areas of minimal to moderate flood hazard outside of the limits of the 100-Year and 500-Year floods.

Federal law requires that flood insurance policy be obtained as a condition of a federally backed mortgage or loan if the building is in a Special Flood hazard Area (SFHA). In addition, flood insurance is available but not required in the un-shaded and shaded "X" Zone.

This determination is based on the Flood Insurance Rate Map of the City and location information provided by recipient or their representative. This letter does not imply that the referenced property will or will not be free from flooding or damage. A property not in a Special Flood Hazard Area may be damaged by a flood greater than that predicted on the FIRM or from a local drainage problem not shown on the map. This letter does not create liability on the part of the City, or any officer or employee thereof, for any damage that results from reliance on this determination.
